- 5. Now go to worksheet PEOPLE. Highlight cell AG3 and go to *Data > Validate* on the main menu.
- 6. Under *Allowed* choose **List**, and for *Source* put **=ACTION**.
- 7. You've now created a selector for your ACTION descriptor.

TASK 29.3.8: Set up the CTA selector

CTA's options are sixfold, depending on what you want your prospect to do next.

- 1. Go to your SELECTORS worksheet.
- 2. Label cell M3 with CTA.
- 3. In cells M4-M10, put your selector options: ***, explore me, contact me, call me, arrange visit, take offer, book project.
- 4. Highlight cells M4-M10 and name the range CTA in the toolbar.
- 5. Now go to worksheet PEOPLE. Highlight cell AH3 and go to *Data > Validate* on the main menu.
- 6. Under *Allowed* choose **List**, and for *Source* put **=CTA**.
- 7. You've now created a selector for your CTA descriptor.

TASK 29.3.9: Set up the PS selector

There are six PS options, for adding that little extra at the end that seals the deal.

- 1. Go to your SELECTORS worksheet.
- 2. Label cell N3 (next to CTA) with PS.
- 3. In cells N4-N10, put your selector options: ***, create curiosity, summarise offer, restate benefit, create urgency, give bonus, make promise.
- 4. Highlight cells N4-N10 and name the range PS in the toolbar.
- 5. Now go to worksheet PEOPLE. Highlight cell AI3 and go to *Data > Validate* on the main menu.
- 6. Under *Allowed* choose **List**, and for *Source* put **=PS**.
- 7. You've now created a selector for your PS descriptor.

This part of your SELECTORS worksheet should now look like this.
